Our Shared Vision

GreenFaith works at the intersection of faith, climate, and justice to build the moral force for systemic change. Together, we are calling on leaders everywhere to:

1. Stop new fossil fuel projects and environmental destruction.
2. Support a just transition to clean, renewable energy.
3. Make polluters pay for the damage they've caused.

This is how we build a world rooted in justice, compassion, and care.

What Is a GreenFaith Circle?

A GreenFaith Circle is a small group – usually 5 to 10 or more people – who come together to take spirit-rooted action for the planet.

Each Circle connects local faith-based action to a global movement for justice, dignity, and care for creation. Circles can be:

- Green teams in congregations, mosques, temples, or synagogues.
- Multi-faith alliances in towns or on campuses.
- Identity- or issue-based groups like Youth Circles or Muslim Women for Climate Justice. Every Circle is unique – but all share one belief: climate justice is a moral and spiritual imperative.

Why Join or Start a Circle?

Because your faith calls you to act – and you don't have to act alone. Circles are:

- **Spiritually grounded** – drawing courage from prayer, ritual, song, and reflection.
- **Community-based** – building relationships across faiths and movements
- **Action-oriented** – taking bold steps for clean energy, environmental justice, and human dignity.
- **Movement-aligned** - connecting people of faith to the broader climate movement.

When you join or start a Circle, you become part of something larger: a global network of faith-led activists transforming despair into hope.



How Circles Make an Impact

Across four continents, Circles are transforming faith into action. They:

- Anchor local campaigns and adapt them to their communities.
- Develop new leaders through mentoring and shared leadership.
- Collaborate with frontline and environmental justice partners.
- Celebrate victories through worship, song, and community gatherings.

From Jakarta, New York to Nairobi, Paris to Portland, Circles are lifting a moral voice for climate justice – together.
